## What is the Methow Valley Community Center?

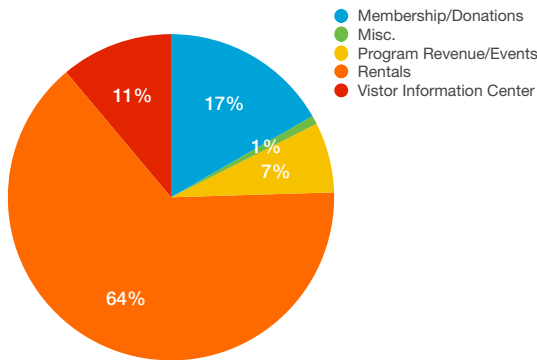

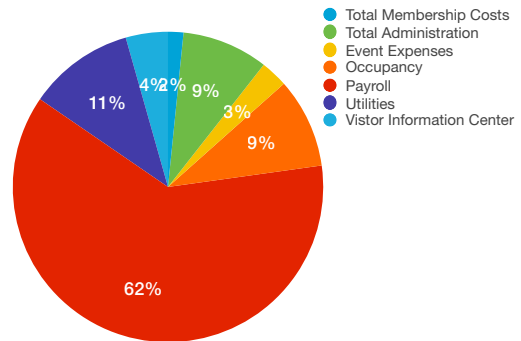
