The MVCCA Board meets on the 2nd Monday of the month in the gym or library from 2-4. You are welcome to join us by calling the office at 997-2926.

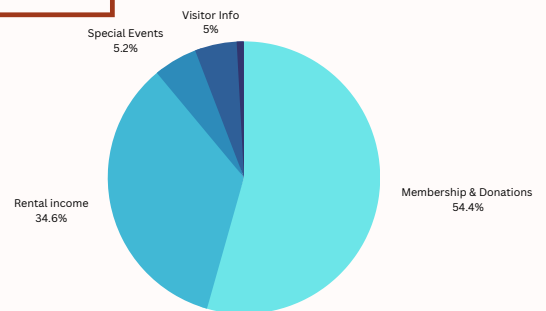
