History

We are honored to take care of this iconic 1912 Twisp building. In 1976, over 50 local folks volunteered their time and money to clean the unused Twisp School and convert the building to house a community center including the Twisp Library, local dispatch, Red McComb's office, LFW Dance and a teen center complete with a wall of pinball machines.

Did you know?

The foundation of the Community Center is 27" thick and timbers used in the roof are 12"x24". Those were some big trees!
